

Pianist, Professor, Sangyoun Lee

Pianist Sangyoun Lee is currently a faculty member at BaekSeok University Music Department, Seoul, Korea. She was educated at Sunhwa Arts Middle School and Sunhwa Arts High School as a young artist and earned her bachelor's degree from the Ewha Womans University in Seoul, Korea. She continued her studies in the United States and earned her Masters of Music and Doctor of Musical Arts degrees at the University of Southern California. As a solo pianist, she has given many solo recitals in both Seoul and the US at such venues as the Seoul Arts Center and the

Alfred Newman Hall. She has also concertized extensively throughout Korea with numerous professional orchestras and chamber ensembles. She has been invited to give solo recitals and to play with ensembles and orchestras by many famous concert halls in Germany, Austria, Czech Republic, Rumania, Bulgaria, and Hungary. Her piano repertoire includes works by Mozart, Beethoven, Brahms, Grieg, Mendelssohn, and Shostakovich, among others. In 2000, she was invited to perform with Brasov Philharmonic Orchestra, Romania for their Mozart Festival. During three years, 2005-2008, summer and winter breaks, she continually played piano concerto with Janacek Philharmonic Orchestra. In 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2015, she played piano recitals in Bautzen, Dresden, Germany, and Hungary. In addition, she was invited to play a duo recital at the Liszt Hall with Mihaly Duffek, the Dean of Music Department of Debrecen University, Hungary. Sangyoun Lee is also building a reputation as an administrator, creating international connections on behalf of Baeseok University. In March 2014, she initiated and successfully developed a collaboration program through a Memorandum of Understanding with the University of Debrecen, Hungary, allowing students at the two schools to cross-register and transfer credits. In January, 2016, as a delegate of BaekSeok University, she invited 'Music Fest Perugia,' a music camp program, to BaekSeok University's Seoul Campus. For this camp, Lee invited world's leading piano pedagogues such as Jerome Lowenthal of the Juilliard School, John Perry of the Glenn Gould School, Michael Lewin of the Boston Conservatory, Sasha Starcevich, the Co-director of Music Fest Perugia, and Ilana Vered, Director of Music Fest Perugia, and led the program and its competition to success.
